Concord, NH: Speaker Packard (R-Londonderry) responds to appointing Representative Kenneth Weyler (R-Kingston) as Chair of the House Finance Committee:

“We have moved on from Representative Weyler’s missteps last year, for which he admitted fault, and paid a price for that.
