Rep. Schmidt moved that the Committee make a preliminary objection to Final Proposal 2018-35 on the grounds as outlined in the annotations by Committee staff to the Final Proposal.

6. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2018-21 from the Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators (Application Procedures; Continued Status; Ethical Standards). Robert Lamberti from the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification testified for the Board.

The Board had submitted a conditional approval request in a letter and amended rules dated August 14, 2018.

Rep. Schmidt moved that the Committee conditionally approve Final Proposal 2018-21 with the understanding that the Board will look into the past use of the aggravating and mitigating circumstances to set fine amounts in disciplinary hearings, keep track of the use of aggravating and mitigating circumstances in future proceedings, and provide clearer guidance on how the aggravating and mitigating circumstances are used by the Board when sanctioning or fining an individual.

Sen. Kahn moved that the Committee conditionally approve Final Proposal 2018-93 based on the request.

The Office had submitted a conditional approval request in a letter and amended rues dated August 14, 2018.

Rep. Schmidt moved that the Committee conditionally approved Final Proposal 2018-94 based on the request.
