Sen. Bradley opposes bill to evade immigration checkpoints

CONCORD, NH - Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro) issued this statement today following the Senate's 14-10 vote to reject HB 579, a bill which would have required New Hampshire law enforcement to notify the public before federal immigration checkpoints are conducted:

“It makes no sense to give traffickers bringing fentanyl and illegal immigrants across our borders prior notice so they can evade immigration checkpoints. Even members of our Congressional delegation are finally admitting that we have a problem with border enforcement. We shouldn't be making it harder to prevent illegal border crossings and drug smuggling.”
