Senate Passes Rent Exemption for Charitable Gaming Facilities

CONCORD, NH – Senator Tim Lang (R-Sanbornton), released the following statement today on the Senate passing HB 1203, relative to prohibiting the charging of rent to charities by charitable gaming facilities:

“Charitable gaming is about benefitting charities, which in turn benefits our New Hampshire residents in need. As charitable gaming has grown in New Hampshire, it is no longer necessary for game operators to charge rent to the charities the system is benefitting. Removing this cost will ensure that a greater share of charitable gaming revenues will flow to the local charities that will put it to good use. More money to charities means more help for Granite Staters.”
