## Sen. Bradley opposes attempts to undermine or repeal EFA's

SB 237 limits eligibility for popular program
SB 432 seeks to shut down the program altogether by 2024

CONCORD, NH – Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro), prime sponsor of the legislation creating the state's Education Freedom Account program (EFA's) with SB 130 in 2021, issued the following statement today opposing SB 237 and SB 432:

"Our Education Freedom Accounts have proven to be more successful than anyone imagined. Currently, 1,635 students are enrolled in the EFA program, giving working families the power to choose the best educational path for them. The pandemic has shown us the need for greater educational options, especially for families who traditionally could not afford the choices wealthier families have always had. EFA's provide that pathway. Students of hard-working families of modest means deserve the opportunity for education choices that best suit their needs."
