Sen. Giuda applauds passage of Parental Bill of Rights (HB 1431)

CONCORD, NH – Sen. Bob Giuda (R-Warren) issued the following statement today on the passage of HB 1431:

“I co-sponsored HB 1431 because I strongly believe that parental rights are critical to the success and the future of our entire society. In my opinion, the government has an obligation to protect those fundamental rights, making sure they are not infringed upon. HB 1431 creates the mechanism by which parents can be notified regarding the health, education, and well-being of their minor children when they are in school. Since parents are the ultimate decision-makers in their minor child’s life, no information – including school records, disciplinary actions, medical treatment, psychological counseling, curriculum plans, and instructional materials - should be kept from them.”
