Senate protects NH residents from out-of-state taxes Votes not to allow income tax on wages earned from out-of-state employers (HB 1097)

CONCORD, NH – Sen. Bob Giuda (R-Warren) issued the following statement today on the passage of HB 1097:

“Working remotely is here to stay and we want our state laws to support this employment arrangement because it’s highly beneficial to so many hard-working Granite Staters affected by out-of-state taxation. This bill makes clear that New Hampshire residents who work remotely in New Hampshire for an out-of-state employer should not be forced to pay income tax in the state where their employer is located. If you never set foot in another state to work, you shouldn’t be required to pay that state’s income tax. Republicans continue to unequivocally support our state’s ‘no income tax policy’ which is a major part of our successful conservative fiscal philosophy.”
