Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 General Provisions; Fish and Game; Definitions. Amend RSA 207:1, XXV to read as follows:

2 XXV. Set Line: A set line [is-an-unattended-line] means any unattended line which is

3 placed in the freshwaters of the state, including through the ice, for the purpose of taking

4 fish which is not under the direct view and control of the person placing the line.

5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

House Fish and Game and Marine Resources Committee January 14, 2010

Good afternoon Mr. Chair and members of the Committee. For the record my name is Timothy Acerno and I am the Assistant Chief of Law Enforcement for the Fish and Game Department. The Department requested this bill and the Fish and Game Commission voted to support it.

The Department continues to work with the Legislature to identify and correct any problems that may come to light while enforcing or administering the various programs. While the current definition of a set line in RSA 207:1 does identify a set line as we understand it, there are some circumstances the Department feels need to be addressed.
