Q: Rep Hunt – Read statute; concerns felonies and refusing license. Believes cannot refuse license.

A: Mr. Glennon – Believes we can refuse a license; say theft issues would be grounds to refuse.

Q: Rep. Nord – Is fee in Part IV new?

A: Fee was never part of the statute; makes things equal.
