Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Planning Board Members Serving on Other Local Boards. Amend RSA 673:7, I to read as

- follows:

  I. In the case of towns, appointed or elected members of the planning board may also serve
  on any other municipal board or commission, provided that such multiple membership does not
  result in 2 planning board members serving on the [same] zoning board of adjustment,
  conservation commission, heritage commission, or other land use board or commission.
  - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
