Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Reference Corrected. Amend RSA 270-D:13, I(a) to read as follows:

2 (a) Passes a safe boater education course approved by the commissioner in accordance 3 with the criteria of the National Association of State Boating Law [Administration] 4 Administrators. A classroom course shall provide a minimum of 8 hours of instruction. Passage of 5 a safe boater education course shall require successful completion of a proctored examination 6 administered by a person authorized by the commissioner in accordance with rules adopted by the 7 commissioner. The minimum passing grade for the examination shall be 80 percent; or

8 2 Certificate Not Required. Amend RSA 270-D:15 to read as follows:
