HOUSE BILL **630**

AN ACT requiring state agencies, boards, and commissions to submit a report to the senate and house finance committees concerning the need for fee increases or new fees.

SPONSORS: Rep. Infantine, Hills 13

COMMITTEE: Executive Departments and Administration

ANALYSIS

This bill requires state agencies, boards, and commissions that seek to increase the amount of a fee or the establishment of a new fee, where such fees are required to produce estimated revenues equal to 125 percent of direct operating expenses, to submit a report to the senate and house finance committees outlining the specific need for the new or increased fee.

- 6 expenses, shall be required to submit a report to the chairpersons of the senate and house finance
- 7 committees outlining the specific need for the new or increased fee.
- 8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.




