HB1265 – This bill was filed to set criteria for licensing of all occupations in New Hampshire. The Committee met numerous times, and reviewed occupations requiring licensing. There are some occupations that currently require licensing that some members felt that they didn't need to be. Instead of the broad brush stoke of this bill it was decided that individual bills addressing those occupations would be a better vehicle to use so this bill is not recommended for further action.

Rep Ken Hawkins

H1317, relative to certifying electricians as fire suppression equipment and alarm installers, is not recommended for future legislation as this Bill was over-reaching and not what anyone wanted.

Mark Proulx

HB1609 is recommended for future legislation. This bill was put forth to clarify existing law, at JLCAR request, so that rules could be passed by the board of respiratory care practitioners. The Respiratory board also added some things, confusing the original bill, but a resubmittal is recommended.

HB476, establishing an independent board of psychologists. Not recommended for further legislation. This bill was overtaken by events, since SB343 accomplished its goal
