**ANALYSIS**

This resolution designates Miss New Hampshire, of the Miss America Scholarship Program, the official honorary hostess of the state of New Hampshire during her term as Miss New Hampshire.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twelve*

A RESOLUTION designating Miss New Hampshire, of the Miss America Scholarship Program, the official honorary hostess of the state of New Hampshire during her term as Miss New Hampshire.

1       Whereas, the Miss America Scholarship Program, established in 1921, and its preliminary  
2 pageants comprise the largest women's scholarship foundation in the world, offering \$45 million to  
3 its contestants nationwide in 2002 alone; and

4       Whereas, it is the oldest, most prestigious competition for young women in America, and unlike  
5 other contests, is a non-profit endeavor; and

6       Whereas, the Miss America organization provides its participants with a vehicle to further their  
7 personal and professional goals and instills a spirit of community service through a variety of unique  
8 nationwide community-based programs; and

9       Whereas, the Miss New Hampshire pageant held its first contest in 1948 and has done so each  
10 year as the official preliminary for the Miss America pageant; and

11       Whereas, the pageant's participants, who are interested foremost in their education, are judged  
12 on the basis of the whole person including talent, intelligence, poise, beauty, spirit, as well as their  
13 platform, and seek to represent New Hampshire in the annual national pageant; and

14       Whereas, a young woman possessing these attributes would be an ideal person to serve as the  
15 official honorary hostess of New Hampshire; and

16       Whereas, many other states, including Nevada, Arkansas, Arizona, Mississippi, South Carolina,  
17 Missouri, Louisiana, Florida, Kentucky, and Hawaii have their respective official preliminary Miss  
18 America contestant winners serve as official hostesses of their states; and

19       Whereas, it would be a great benefit to the state of New Hampshire to have a Miss  
20 New Hampshire serve as the official honorary hostess to assist the governor with ceremonial  
21 functions such as welcoming visiting dignitaries, attending important events, and assisting with  
22 various duties that may arise; now, therefore be it

23       Resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

24       That the members of the New Hampshire general court of the state of New Hampshire proclaim  
25 that the woman chosen as Miss New Hampshire of the Miss America Scholarship Program serve as  
26 the official honorary hostess of New Hampshire during her term as Miss New Hampshire; and

27       That the clerk of the house of representatives transmit copies of this concurrent resolution,  
28 signed by the speaker of the house of representatives and the senate president, to the Miss  
29 New Hampshire Scholarship Program, the current reigning Miss New Hampshire, the Miss America  
30 Scholarship Program Organization, and the governor of the state of New Hampshire.

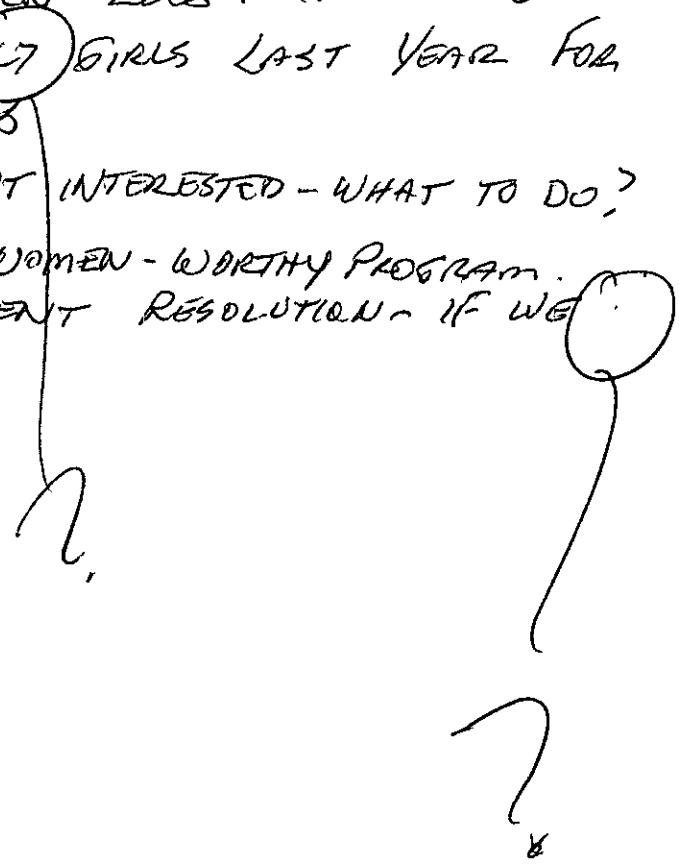
