Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Excavating and Dredging Permit; Certain Exemptions; Use of Best Management Practices. 1 RSA 482-A:3, XVI(a) is repealed and reenacted to read as follows: 2 XVI.(a) Any municipality that has a professional engineer ensure that best management 3 practices for routine roadway maintenance in New Hampshire published by the department of 4 transportation are followed by its employees or contractors who install, repair, or replace culverts or 5 stream crossing structures, including culverts up to and including 48 inches in diameter or the 6 functional hydraulic equivalent, and that files an appropriate notice under subparagraph (b) shall be 7 exempt from the permitting requirement of RSA 482-A:3, I(a). 8
- 9 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
