Summary of testimony received:

- Senator Rausch opened the hearing at 10:30am.
- Senator Carson stated that soldiers the bridge would be named for are both from Londonderry and died in the War on Terror. The bridge would be called the Sora/Currier Memorial Bridge. She continued that Lance Corporal Peter J. Sora, know as PJ was a 2002 graduate of Londonderry High School. He joined the Marines in 2003 and died in 2004 in a training accident while preparing for deployment. Senator Carson went on to explain that Private First Class Eric D. Currier

graduated from Londonderry High School in 2007 and joined the Marines in 2009. He was deployed and killed in 2010. Both soldiers left behind grieving families and friends and Private First Class Currier had recently married. Senator Carson stated that these men died to protect our freedoms and naming this newly constructed bridge in Londonderry would be appropriate in honoring their sacrifice. She explained that the bridge is on the newly constructed airport access road and the bridge on the opposite end is the Pearl Harbor Memorial Bridge. The bridge to be named is currently the Little Coos Brook Bridge and the Department of Transportation said it is available to be named. Senator Carson also stated that she is offering to assume any cost for signage.
