Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

8 329:31-a Food and Drug Administration Approval Not Required. A physician required to be 9 licensed under this chapter may dispense medication and use equipment and therapies which are not 10 approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration.

11 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
