Summary of testimony presented in support:

Rep. John Graham (testimony provided) stated he wanted to make full disclosure he is the state treasurer for the New Hampshire American Legion, and also prime sponsor of this legislation.

- This bill asks that current law be changed. The law currently was written in 1920 stating that office space be provided within the State House for the NH Department of American Legion.
- In 1972 office space was moved from the State House to the state annex.
- Current law states that the housing provided be in the State House.
- There is presently an open office suite at Gallen Office Park and, which is currently being renovated.

- Rep. Graham has talked with the Department of Administrative Services and the American Legion about moving from the state Annex to the Gallen Office Park. Further discussion with the Commissioner of Administrative Services indicated that they would feel more comfortable to see the law changed to indicate, instead of an office in the State House it state, "in the City of Concord".
- Discussion of parking being a problem and employees were presently searching for parking, and this move would help that situation. Senator Soucy asked if there was anyone opposed to this legislation on the Houseside. Rep. Graham stated no one was opposed to this legislation, and that it was on the House Consent Calendar with no debate.

LAWS OF 1921, CHAPTER 175

JOINT RESOULUTION PROVIDING FOR PERMANENT HEADQUARTERS IN THE STATE HOUSE FOR THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE AMERICAN LEGION
