AN ACT making technical corrections to the International Registration Plan.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 International Registration Plan; Definitions. Amend RSA 260:75, article II, paragraphs LL
2 and MM to read as follows:

3 LL. [~~Repository~~] "**Reciprocity**" means the reciprocal grant by one jurisdiction of operating
4 rights or privileges to properly registered vehicles registered by another jurisdiction, especially but
5 not exclusively including privileges generally conferred by vehicle registration.
