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ANALYSIS

This bill removes obsolete references to the New Hampshire Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association on the state building code review board and the advisory committee on heating system certification.

AN ACT relative to plumbers and mechanical contractors on state boards.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1       1 State Building Code Review Board; Members. Amend RSA 155-A:10, I(m) to read as follows:  
2           (m) One mechanical contractor, primarily engaged in the business of mechanical  
3 construction, nominated by the [~~New Hampshire Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association~~]  
4 ***Plumbers, Fuel Gas Fitters, and HVAC Association of New Hampshire.***  
5       2 Repeal. RSA 153:16-c, III(g), relative to the representative of the New Hampshire Plumbing  
6 and Mechanical Contractors Association on the advisory committee on heating system certification,  
7 is repealed.  
8       3 Applicability. Section 2 of this act shall not apply to the representative of the New Hampshire  
9 Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association serving on the advisory committee on heating  
10 system certification on the effective date of this act. Section 2 shall apply upon the expiration of such  
11 member's current term of office.  
12       4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Bill Analysis:** This bill removes obsolete references to the New Hampshire Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association on the state building code review board and the advisory committee on heating system certification.

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**Sponsors:** Sen. Carson, Dist 14; Sen. Cataldo, Dist 6; Sen. Reagan, Dist 17; Rep. C. McGuire, Merr 29

**Who supports the bill:** Senator Carson, Senator Reagan, Senator Cataldo, Paul Morin, Plumbers, Fuel Gas Fitters, and HVAC Association of NH, Tricia Newhall Grahame, Plumbers, Fuel Gas Fitters, and HVAC Association of NH

**Who opposes the bill:** No opposition.

**Summary of testimony presented in support:**

- **Senator Carson** opened stating this bill was a housekeeping bill and that the New Hampshire Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association is now a new organization called the Plumbers, Fuel Gas Fitters, and HVAC Association of New Hampshire. Language is being replaced accordingly from one organization with another and deleting references which are obsolete.

- **Paul Morin** representing the Plumbers, Fuel Gas Fitters, and HVAC Association of New Hampshire stating currently there is a seat on the Building Code Review Board for the Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association and the person presently holding that seat also holds a seat on the Plumbers, Fuel Gas

Fitters, and HVAC Association of New Hampshire. This bill seeks to replace one member from one board to the new board.

- The New Hampshire Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association are closing their doors and the new association, Plumbers, Fuel Gas Fitters, and HVAC Association of New Hampshire is taking their place representing the industry. The member presently on the old board should serve out their term on the new board.

- The second section of the bill deals with the Advisory Committee which currently has a seat for both associations. The person in that seat would serve out their term with the new association and would not be removed.
