### **Summary of testimony presented in support:**

Senator Forrester, Prime Sponsor:

- This legislation renames the Mount Washington overlook in Bretton Woods in honor of former Executive Councilor Raymond S. Burton. The design cost, construction, maintenance and installation of any signage will not be charged to the state.
- Senator Forrester developed Amendment #2014-0413s, which also names the visitor center located on the northbound side of I-93 in Hooksett as the Raymond S. Burton Visitor Center. All signs identifying the visitor center shall be displayed inside the visitor center, and will not be charged to the state. The two developers of the visitor center project, Alex Ray and Rusty McLear, requested the amendment. The plan is to place a copy of Councilor Burton's photograph from the Executive Council Chambers and an accompanying plaque inside the entrance to the center.
- Senator Forrester indicated District 4 Executive Councilor Chris Pappas is very supportive of the bill.
- Senator Stiles sought confirmation the northbound visitor center is the only center affected, and not the southbound side of I-93 in Hooksett. Senator Forrester agreed.
- The Commissioner of DOT was consulted and helped draft the language of this bill.

**Action:** Senator Forrester made a motion to accept Amendment #2014-0413s; Senator Stiles seconded the motion. Senator Forrester then made a motion of Ought to Pass as Amended; Senator Stiles seconded the motion. On a vote of 3-0, SB 357 passed. Senator Forrester will report the bill out of committee.
