Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Section; Ataxia Awareness Day. Amend RSA 4 by inserting after section 13-t the following new section:
  3 4:13-u Ataxia Awareness Day. The governor shall annually proclaim September 25 as Ataxia Awareness Day and shall urge cities and towns throughout the state to observe this day in an appropriate manner in recognition of the thousands of citizens of this state affected by hereditary and sporadic ataxia, and the need for public awareness, research, and support for victims and their families.
- 8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
