#### Summary of testimony presented in support:

Sen. Boutin, Dist 16

- Full service restaurants can ask the NH Liquor Commission, and be approved to serve table wine and store the bottle on premises as long as the customer is eating a full service mean. The bottle belongs to the customer and they pay the restaurant a corking fee. Current law only applies to full service restaurants.
- This bill extends that policy to country clubs that provide full service meals.
- This is a simple pro-business bill.

Commissioner Joseph Mollica, NH Liquor Commission

• This bill extends a provision that already exists, agrees with the prime sponsor. This is done in several states. There are 18 control states and many have this provision. This will not be a problem to enforce.

Paul K. Foury, Manchester Country Club

• Supports the bill, we can comply with the law and we just want to offer this service to our customers.
