STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to the membership of the medical review subcommittee.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Disciplinary Action; Remedial Proceedings; Medical Review Subcommittee. Amend RSA
2 329:17, V-a to read as follows:

3 V-a. A medical review subcommittee of [~~11~~] **13** members shall be nominated by the board of
4 medicine and appointed by the governor and council. The subcommittee shall consist of one
5 member of the board of medicine and [~~10~~] **12** other persons, 3 of whom shall be public members, one
6 of whom shall be a physician assistant, and [~~6~~] **8** of whom shall be physicians. Any public member
7 of the subcommittee shall be a person who is not, and never was, a member of the medical
8 profession or the spouse of any such person, and who does not have, and never has had, a material
9 financial interest in either the provision of medical services or an activity directly related to
10 medicine, including the representation of the board or profession for a fee at any time during the 5
11 years preceding appointment. The terms of the public members shall be staggered so that no 2
12 public members' terms expire in the same year. The subcommittee members shall be appointed for
13 3-year terms, and shall serve no more than 2 terms. Upon referral by the board, the subcommittee
14 shall review disciplinary actions reported to the board under paragraphs II-V of this section, except
15 that matters concerning a medical director involved in a current internal or external grievance
16 pursuant to RSA 420-J shall not be reviewed until the grievance process has been completed.
17 Following review of each case, the subcommittee shall make recommendations to the board. Funds
18 shall be appropriated from the general fund for use by the subcommittee to investigate allegations
19 under paragraphs I-V of this section. The board shall employ a physician as a medical review
20 subcommittee investigator who shall serve at the pleasure of the board. The salary of the medical
21 review subcommittee investigator shall be established by RSA 94:1-a.

22 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
