**HB 466-FN- FISCAL NOTE**

AN ACT (New Title) relative to farm tractor plates for certain specialized vehicles.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The Department of Safety states this bill, **as amended by the House (Amendment #2015-2471h)**, will decrease state and local revenue by an indeterminable amount in FY 2017 and each year thereafter and decrease state expenditures by an indeterminable amount in FY 2018 and each year thereafter. There will be no impact on county revenues or state, county, and local expenditures.

**METHODOLOGY:**

The Department of Safety states this bill allows certain specialized vehicles used for agriculture purpose to qualify for farm tractor plates provided their use is limited exclusively to agriculture and farming purposes. According to the Department, the current state annual registration fee for construction equipment is \$25.00 and annual registration fee for a farm tractor is \$1.80.

Therefore, the reduction in state revenue for each vehicle would be \$23.20 (\$25.00 - \$1.80). The Department is unable to estimate how many of the 6,882 vehicles currently registered fall within the specific types identified in this bill would register for farm tractor plates and therefore cannot estimate a total impact on state revenue. Additionally, this bill would reduce state expenditures and local revenue relative to highway block grant as pursuant to RSA 235:23, 12 percent of total road toll revenue and motor vehicle fees are distributed to cities and towns pursuant to the specified formula in the following year.

The Department of Safety further states this bill will decrease local revenue by an indeterminable amount as the vehicles specified in this bill, currently registered as construction vehicles, pay a municipal fee based upon weight and body style. The Department states the average fee is \$48.10 and if registered as a farm tractor the fee would be \$5.00, a reduction in revenue of \$43.10 (\$48.10 - \$5.00) per vehicle.

*Rep. McGuire*

- This bill was put forward as a request from a constituent who is a farmer and frequently uses a backhoe as part of working his farm. His constituent explained that he typically gets a very reasonable rate when he registers his farm equipment, but equipment like a backhoe is registered as construction equipment and costs several hundred dollars.
- This bill would allow farmers who use other types of tools or vehicles to register their tools under the "farm price" on a registration instead of the price of equipment used for construction.
- House Transportation added part III to this legislation, which states that a farmer must sign a statement that they know not to use the equipment for anything other than farming.

This bill allows certain specialized vehicles used for agricultural purposes to qualify for farm tractor plates. Some equipment, such as backhoes, is required to be registered as construction equipment, costing farmers hundreds of dollars. Farmers must sign a statement stating that they will not use the equipment for any purpose other than farming.
