

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Seventeen*

AN ACT           repealing the commuters income tax.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1       1 Repeal. RSA 77-B, relative to the commuters income tax, is repealed.
- 2       2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
