AN ACT relative to the judicial district for the towns of Waterville and Livermore.

ANALYSIS

This bill moves the towns of Livermore and Waterville from the Conway judicial district to the Plymouth-Lincoln judicial district.

SB 336 - AS AMENDED BY THE SENATE

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Eighteen

AN ACT relative to the judicial district for the towns of Waterville and Livermore.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 District Courts; Judicial Districts. Amend RSA 502-A:1, X to read as follows:

X. CONWAY DISTRICT. The district for northern Carroll county shall consist of the towns of Conway, Bartlett, Jackson, Eaton, Chatham, Hart's Location, Albany, Madison and the unincorporated places of Hale's Location, Cutt's Grant, and Hadley's Purchase[, and those portions of the towns of Waterville and Livermore within the watershed of the Saco River and its tributaries]. The district court for the district shall be located in Conway, holding sessions regularly therein and elsewhere in the district as justice may require. The name of the court shall be the Conway District Court.

2 District Courts; Judicial Districts. Amend RSA 502-A:2, XXIX to read as follows:

10 XXIX. PLYMOUTH-LINCOLN DISTRICT. The Plymouth-Lincoln district shall consist of 11 the towns of Plymouth, Bristol, Groton, Wentworth, Rumney, Ellsworth, Thornton, Campton, 12 Ashland, Hebron, Holderness, Bridgewater, Alexandria, Lincoln, Woodstock [and those portions of 13 the towns of], Livermore, and Waterville [not-within the watershed of the Saco River and its 14 tributaries]. The district court for the district shall be located in Plymouth, holding sessions 15 regularly therein and elsewhere in the district as justice may require. The name of the court shall 16 be Plymouth District Court.
