Summary of testimony presented:

Christian Citarello, Property Casualty Actuary for the NH Insurance Department:

- Citarello said that this bill only affects the scheduling rating piece of commercial lines and it isn't often that the department sees an insurer who wants to include administrative costs rather than the risks of the insured to be built into their scheduled rating.
- Citarello said that doing so is currently prohibited, but this bill would allow it.

Senator Soucy asked what the special costs would be.

• Citarello said that a business owner, regarding workers compensation, may have a very simple employee such as all being in one class code, so the audits would be very easy. He said therefore it may be easier to administer that policy. Senator Soucy asked him to clarify if he was talking about systems that see less administrative costs and therefore can see savings due to these situations. Citarello said that yes, the rates regarding these policies would be less related to risk than they would be for processing.
