Summary of testimony presented in support:

Senator Hennessey

- This bill repeals the salary differential for the associate justices of the Concord, Nashua, and Manchester district courts.
- This bill was at the request of the Judicial Branch.

Howard Zibel (Judicial Branch) (provided written testimony)

- This is a simple bill to end an anachronism in the statute.
- RSA 502-A:6 currently states that the salaries for the associate justices of the Manchester, Nashua, and Concord district courts shall be \$300 less than the amount paid to the justice, as written in paragraph 1.
- Paragraph 1 no long governs the payment to judges.
- For many years, the salaries of these justices have been included in the budget.
- The Judicial Branch has been following the budget bills.
- Senator Levesque asked if there is any differential in pay for judges.
 - Superior court and circuit court judges make the same amount of money. The chief justice of the superior court, administrative judge of the circuit court, and the associate justices of the Supreme Court make a little more. The chief justice of the Supreme Court makes slightly more than that.
- Senator Levesque asked if those differentials are no longer referred to in this statute.

TITLE LI COURTS

CHAPTER 502-A DISTRICT COURTS

Section 502-A:6

502-A:6 Salaries of Justices, Special Justices, Clerks. -

The annual salaries of justices, special justices and clerks of the district courts shall be paid by the state as follows:

I. The state shall pay the justices of the district courts either (a) salaries based upon weighted caseload as provided in RSA 491-A:3; or (b) their annual salaries prior to the enactment of RSA 491-A:3; whichever is greater.

La Salary of Associate Justice, Manchester, Nashuarand Concord District Courts, The annual salary of the associate justices of the Manchester District Court, the NashuarDistrict Court and the Concord District Court shall each be an amount \$300 less than the amount paid the justice thereof as provided in paragraph 1.

II. The annual salaries of the special justices of the district courts appointed prior to July 1, 1987, shall be an amount equal to 30 percent of the salary paid to the justices, as provided in paragraph I, or the current annual salary of the special justice for 1987, whichever is greater. Provided further that the special justice may receive, and all special justices appointed after July 1, 1987, shall receive, per diem compensation determined by the supreme court upon recommendation by the judicial branch administrative council, plus reasonable expenses as determined by the supreme court. In those cases where prior to July 1, 1987, the special justice was paid on a per diem basis, such per diem payment shall continue unless changed by the supreme court. In the event of the death, resignation, or retirement of the justice and when no appointment is made to fill the vacancy caused thereby for a period of 60 days, the special justice shall then be paid the salary of the justice until his vacancy is filled. If the justice is absent due to illness or disqualification for any other reason for a period of more than 60 days, the special justice or special justice sits in another court by request, he or she shall be paid the same per diem compensation as is generally allowed to per diem special justices sitting in their own courts, plus reasonable expenses.
