This bill changes the membership and term requirements for the professional standards board that advises the state board of education.

AN ACT                   relative to membership on the professional standards board.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           1 Education; Professional Standards Board; Membership. Amend RSA 186:60, I(c) to read as  
2 follows:

3                   (c) [9] 3 members representing higher education and *6 members representing*  
4 education administration; and

5           2 Education; Professional Standards Board; Terms of Members. Amend RSA 186:60, III to read  
6 as follows:

7                   III. The appointed members of the board shall serve for 3-year terms and may not serve for  
8 more than 2 *consecutive* full terms.

9           3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
