Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Operation of Games of Chance; Charitable Organization Personnel. Amend RSA 287-D:14, XI

A member of the sponsoring charitable organization shall be present and on site [at least once per day] during the operation of any game of chance at least once within the contract period and shall file with the lottery commission an affidavit attesting to the member's presence at the site during the operation of any games of chance. Summary of testimony presented in support:

#### Senator Tom Sherman

- This bill was requested by a Hampton based charity who was concerned with the current statutory requirements.
- Currently, a sponsoring charitable organization must have a member on-site once per day during the contract period for games of chance. That member is required to sign an affidavit daily attesting to their presence, which is provided to the lottery commission.
- Senator Sherman stated this requirement is burdensome because organization members have day jobs and/or they may not be geographically close.
- This bill would require a member only to be on-site once per contract period. The member would still be required to sign an affidavit, but it would only be once during that period.

- Senator French asked how long contract periods run and if they could have a duration of multiple months.
  - o Senator Sherman responded there are two in his district Ocean Casino and The Brook and they typically have contract periods that run no more than 4 days.
