Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 New Paragraph; Alcohol or Drug Impairment; Definitions. Amend RSA 265-A:1 by inserting 1 after paragraph V the following new paragraph: 2 VI. "Drive," or "attempt to drive," or "actual physical control" shall not include: 3 (a) Sleeping, resting, or sheltering in place in a vehicle parked in any place where 4 5 parking is permitted; (b) Lacking intent to control the vehicle in a manner which could pose a danger to the 6 7 public; or (c) Controlling an inoperable vehicle. 8 9 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
