STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty One

AN ACT repealing RSA 323 regarding lightning rod dealers and salesmen.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Repeal. RSA 323, relative to lightning rod dealers and salesmen, is repealed.
- 2 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2022.
