This bill adds to the harassment laws, which is what cyberflashing is. Persons that receive these unsolicited intimate images, that are incredibly violating don't' always have a recourse. It's illegal to flash someone in person, and we believe that it should also be illegal to do so digitally. The committee believes it should be law, therefore the unsolicited sending of genitalia via electronic device, a violation, with multiple offenses being a class A misdemeanor punishable by a fine up to \$1,000.

AN ACT establishing the crime of unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image.

This bill establishes the offense of unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image.

| 8 | engaged in sexually explicit conduct. |
| 9 | (c) "Send by electronic device" means to send using a cellular telephone or any other |
| 10 | electronic communication device, including devices capable of sending text messages or e-mails. |
| 11 | (d) "Sexually explicit conduct" shall have the same meaning as in RSA 649-A:2, III. |
| 12 | II. A person commits the offense of unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image when: |
| 13 | (a) He or she sends by electronic device an unsolicited intimate image depicting sexually |
| 14 | explicit conduct to a recipient with the intent to harass, annoy, or alarm the recipient; and |
| 15 | (b) The person knows that the recipient has not consented to receiving the image, and |
| 16 | the recipient has not consented to receiving the image; and |
| 17 | (c) The recipient was harassed, annoyed, or alarmed by the receipt of the image. |
| 18 | III. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a violation for a |
| 19 | first offense and a misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense. |

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2022.

METHODOLOGY:

This bill contains penalties that may have an impact on the New Hampshire judicial and correctional systems. There is no method to determine how many charges would be brought as a result of the changes contained in this bill to determine the fiscal impact on expenditures. However, the entities impacted have provided the potential costs associated with these penalties below.

It should be noted that average case cost estimates for FY 2021 and FY 2022 are based on data that is more than ten years old and does not reflect changes to the courts over that same period of time or the impact these changes may have on processing the various case types. An unspecified misdemeanor can be either class A or class B, with the presumption being a class B misdemeanor.

Many offenses are prosecuted by local and county prosecutors. When the Department of Justice has investigative and prosecutorial responsibility or is involved in an appeal, the Department would likely absorb the cost within its existing budget.
