Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

The 14court will appoint an attorney to represent you if your application shows that you are eligible. If you

15 believe that you are eligible for appointed counsel, you may apply prior to your arraignment.

16 Hereof fail not, as you will answer your default under the penalty of the law in that behalf made and
