## Rep. Spillane introduced the bill and spoke in support.

He said that his goal in this bill to better handle administrative rules by ensuring that they are updated before they expire. He saw at a conference (ALEC, in answer to a question) 3 years ago, a software package that would serve notice about when rules were to expire and make an alert for rules that had not been updated for a period of time.

He pointed out that expired rules were no longer effective. He felt that a study committee could examine these issues. In **answer to a question of the Chair, Rep. McGuire** said that we were not establishing study committees this year.

She added that this matter is completely within the charter of the ED&A Committee so it can study the matter on its own initiative without the necessity of legislation.

She said our options were to retain or to ITL the bill.

**Questions and discussion continued** concerning the expiration of rules, the need for timely notice, what other states with administrative rules were doing.

**Comment - Rep. McGuire** said she had a concern about smaller boards with fewer rules; that they can overlook their expirations dates; that OPLC now has a central rule making role.

Public hearing adjourned at 2:25 p.m.

## STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

## In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty One

AN ACT

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establishing a committee to study the expiration and updating of administrative rules.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study the expiration and 2 updating of administrative rules.
  - 2 Membership and Compensation.
    - I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:
  - (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.
    - (b) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.
  - II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to the duties of the committee.
    - 3 Duties. The committee shall determine how many administrative rules in the published rules of state agencies are no longer in effect because they have not been renewed on time and shall study the procedure for purging those rules. The committee shall determine the most appropriate way for administrative rules to be updated under RSA 541-A to ensure that they are always current and enforceable.
    - 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.
    - 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2021.
      - 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
