Dear Chairman Pearson and HHAEA Committee Members:

I write to you in **opposition to HB492 requiring maintenance of the COVID-19 dashboard and ask that you vote to recommend ITL on this bill**.

While we are currently experiencing a COVID-19 pandemic and there are emergency orders that have been issued to provide for emergency actions, this bill proposes to put certain reporting requirements into law as a permanent feature. This would not allow for modification of action and reporting as the pandemic weakens and this becomes an endemic illness more typical of influenza for which we do not have these extensive reporting requirements as are proposed here.

DHHS has done a good job of providing COVID-19 information and details and updating it regularly on their COVID website and reporting to the public. Leaving data reporting decisions at the department level allows for necessary flexibility to report what is needed and useful.

Schools were shut down by order of the governor so it is necessary to gather actual data now to share with the public to guide and reassure them in safely opening schools. Nursing homes, prisons, and congregate living settings were not ordered closed by the governor and do not require the same type of data collection and reporting.

The section calling for tracking of vaccination metrics by age, race, town and eligibility category is particularly concerning for a number of reasons:

1. This would involve the collection and sorting of personal information and there are obvious privacy and security concerns.

2. The CDC and DHHS have already made recommendations on who might want to get a COVID shot.

3. Not everyone can safely get a COVID shot and not everyone wants one.

4. These shots are a treatment offered to minimize symptoms for those at greatest risk. They have not been shown to prevent infection or reduce the spread of infection. Treatment options are important to have. It's never one-size fits all.

5. Reporting of vaccination rates to the public broken out by various locations and demographics is not useful data to the public.

6. Historically the purpose of such collection of data and posting of metrics is to coerce, shame, and bully individuals to submit to vaccination.

7. These COVID injections remain in the experimental phase under Emergency Use Authorization and are not FDA licensed and this fact should be recognized and appreciated.

The production of this dashboard with daily updating to fulfill the requirements in this bill is not without cost and there is no provision in this bill for covering that cost.

DHHS already knows how many COVID shots have been received in the state and how many have been injected. Vaccination use and rates are typically published information

by DHHS without a statutory requirement to do so.

I do not believe it is appropriate to be permanently collecting, sorting, and reporting data to the extent called for in this bill.

I ask that you consider this bill to be appropriate for an ITL recommendation.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

The department of health $\mathbf{2}$ and human services, in collaboration with the university system of New Hampshire, shall maintain 3 a website known as the COVID-19 dashboard to provide timely and accurate information to the 4public regarding the state of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in New Hampshire. The website shall serve as an information clearinghouse, with essential guidance for schools and local $\mathbf{5}$ 6 communities during the pandemic. Separate sections of the dashboard shall track nursing homes, $\mathbf{7}$ prisons, and congregate living settings in the same way that case specific information regarding 8 schools is tracked. Another section of the dashboard shall track vaccination metrics by age, race, 9 town, and eligibility category. Vaccination information shall be maintained in a way that allows for 10 cross-referencing of geographic location, age, race, and eligibility category. The department shall 11 update the dashboard on a daily basis and ensure that it is available to the public 24-hours a day, 7 12days a week.

132 Legislative Committee Established. There is established a committee to study health 14disparities experienced by under-represented populations during the COVID-19 pandemic.

I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

16(a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house 17of representatives, two of whom shall be nominated by the minority leader.

20II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to 21the duties of the committee.

The committee shall consider ways to improve safety for vulnerable 24populations, including prison inmates, nursing home residents, and others living in congregate living 25settings.
