### STATEMENT OF INTENT

This bill would seek to establish a criminal penalty for the assault of another person who is relaying public health or safety guidance or requirements during a declared state of emergency. As written and introduced this bill would make the act of assault, threat of assault, or refusal to comply with another who the actor knows to be a person who as part of his or her employment duties is relaying directions for health care or safety from his or her supervisor or employer or relaying health or safety guidelines contained in a state of emergency declared by the federal, state, or local government a B misdemeanor. Every free person in the state who has constitutionally guaranteed individual freedom and liberties should find this bill repugnant to the constitution and as such null and void. The committee did find the bill so repugnant to the constitution that the committee vote was inexpedient to legislate 20-1.

Every free person in the state who has constitutionally guaranteed individual freedom and liberties should find this bill repugnant to the constitution and as such null and void. The committee did find the bill so repugnant to the constitution that the committee vote was ITL 20-1.

When I was 17 years old, after already having been subjected to pornography as a child, I was coerced into taking my clothes off at a party by the man who later brought me into the strip club industry shortly after my 18th birthday. I then spent close to six years in the commercial sex industry. Those six years

became progressively worse in an environment enmeshed with addiction, exploitation, and false promises.

As written in my first book, my first exposure to pornography was the Larry Flynt Hustler magazine, the most crude at the time in the early 1990's.

That graphic images of adults posed in sexual positions in image, was stamped on my mind as the first very real image of what is not meant to be seen by an 11 year old girl. Shortly after that time, I was shown graphic pornography in video form by a boyfriend at the age of 15. I struggled throughout high school and drug and alcohol use was a part of my lifestyle.

Now, I've been out of the industry since 2006. I am a mother, a wife, a counselor, an author and advocate. I've also been sober since that time. As the executive director of a nonprofit organization that supports and empowers women coming out of exploitation, I can tell you that pornography always some role in their exploitation — and it is not something any child should ever see.

The viewing of pornography, much like the use of a drug, can become increasing in use, often becoming more vulgar. And the truth is, the majority of youth check out porn for the first time at age 10, according to a University of Montreal study.

The average age of first Internet porn exposure is 9- 11 years old.

The danger then, is that children and adolescents can become “de-sensitized” to pornography exposure (like I did), which can result in acting out sexualized behaviors, sometimes with other children, and engaging in high-risk sexual experiences by adolescents.

I've often wondered if my life would have taken the course that it did had I not been subjected to pornography in my youth. No child should ever have to experience surprise by the often time vulgar images that are put forth by pornography.

I'd like to conclude by sharing that interestingly enough, the club that I was brought into was part of the largest strip club chain in the world, part owned by Larry Flynt.

*“I don't hold him responsible for my exploitation, but I recognize his contribution to the history of porn that reeked havoc on my life.”*

Flynt was a partner with Harry Mohny in opening what is now the largest strip club operator in the world and one of the largest adult businesses in history. He also was one of the largest producers of porn in the past.

Brought into this industry as a teenager and out at the age of 25, I do not hold him responsible for the demise this industry caused, but I wonder what can be done to decrease the accessibility of pornography for our youth.

**No one is meant to be a commodity** — Porn seeks to commodify and is demoralizing in nature.

And so I am asking you, how will you keep youth from going down this captive, destructive path that porn ushers in? You get the opportunity to protect our youth and so I'm asking that you also support HB 93.

Whereas, the executive orders have not been subjected to any scientific or concerted legal inquiry relevant to their efficacy or constitutionality, respectively; and

Whereas, the reasonable timeframe for any emergency orders, especially in the absence of independent scientific inquiry and legislative affirmation, is long over; and

There simply is no scientific proof that wearing masks limits viral transmission. Enclosed is a document that the FDA put out to mask manufacturers, distributors, and health care workers on April 24, 2020 stating that, "Authorized face masks must meet the following requirements:

The product labeling includes **recommendations against use in a clinical setting where the infection risk level through inhalation exposure is high**; The product is not labeled in such a manner that would misrepresent the product's intended use; for example, **the labeling must not state or imply that the product is intended for antimicrobial or antiviral protection or related uses or is for use such as infection prevention or reduction**; 5. The product is **not labeled as a respiratory protective device**, and therefore **should not be used for particulate filtration**; and 6. The product is **not labeled for use in high risk aerosol generating procedures.**" The face masks that everyday people are wearing are not FDA approved. The FDA does not allow mask manufacturers to claim that masks prevent viral transmission, as that would be false advertising. Viruses are extremely small particles and cannot be the types of masks available to the general public.

The FDA has not as of yet approved any commercially available vaccine. I have attached a copy of both the Moderna and Pfizer COVID vaccine FDA factsheets for your review and have highlighted the sections where it is stated that **"There is no FDA-approved vaccine to prevent COVID-19."** Both vaccines are being pushed, and it is implied that they are safe and effective. 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Dear Members of the House Criminal Justice and Public Safety Committee:

In December of last year, after much study and thought, I decided to move my law practice, along with my pregnant wife and four children, from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to Franklin, New Hampshire.

We left behind a great deal when we moved from Philadelphia. It was the city where my wife and I were married; the city where four of my children were born and baptized into the Catholic faith; the city where we struggled and suffered through years of schooling to obtain my law degree, and later the practice of law in a busy market, in order to give our family the life they deserved. We had the kind of friends most make only once in a lifetime, a second-to-none church community, and we adored our neighborhood in Philadelphia (the Manayunk-Roxborough section of the city).

Then came COVID-19. Of course, like many of good will, we initially dealt with it and went along with the promises of 14 days to “flatten the curve.” The disease was new, media reports were conflicting, and all felt that 2 weeks was not a huge price to pay if those most vulnerable could be saved. That 2 weeks turned into 8 months and beyond.

We watched with great sadness as all the things we loved about the city were smothered and choked off by the heavy-handed policies of our Mayor and Governor. Our church was shut down. Our neighbors began to bicker and argue, “snitching” on one another for perceived violations of an ever-increasing number of draconian and unreasonable “rules” and “orders.” My daughters’ dance school, which a young woman had put her entire life into building and which we had joined way back when she first started out, was crushed and forced out of business (while many top-tier law firms in the city were using their banking connections to scrape up all the “paycheck protection” funds they could, the little folks like the dance teacher could not even figure out how to apply). The parks, museums, trails, gyms, and co-ops where our children used to gather with their friends and gain much needed interaction were all taken away.

As the science became clearer, it became more evident these policies would continue regardless of whether they made sense or whether they were in fact necessary. I do not know why, and I suppose I never will (though, I suspect it is hard to admit one may have been mistaken, particularly when that mistake has potentially destroyed the livelihoods of an entire generation). As we saw the damage these policies were doing to our community, to our friends and most importantly, to our children unfold. I began taking stock of our options for leaving Pennsylvania. I settled on New Hampshire as the destination for our escape.

New Hampshire, from what I could tell, offered a freedom and a beauty I did not find in the other 49 states. We were attracted by the “Live Free or Die” attitude, the citizen legislators, the fiscal responsibility, and what seemed like the willingness of the government and citizens to hold true to our country’s founding principles of independence and self-determination – principles which have been almost entirely abandoned in many states.

You can imagine my surprise and disappointment when I learned of HB 493 (not to mention SB 155). Both measures are so contrary to the principles that brought me to New Hampshire. Moreover, they are measures that will bring this great State backwards, rather than moving us forward to a greater future. It is well known the science shows that nearly 99% of all people who even encounter this virus will survive. It is well known that the toll draconian and unreasonable restrictions have taken on individuals and businesses, while immeasurable, is certainly greater than that of the virus. At a time when legislatures like the one in the Commonwealth my family and I fled are seeking to take back control unlawfully wrestled from the peoples’ representatives by their Executive Branches, it just makes no sense for New Hampshire to degrade itself with laws like HB493 and SB155.

I am reminded of a quote from Fr. Picot de Cloriviere, an 18th century Catholic priest who spoke out against excesses of the French Revolution, which I will paraphrase here.

Since the creation of the world, there has never been a revolution in which irrationality has been so blatantly manifested and simultaneously carried to such monstrous and extravagant excesses. Yet, it has spread with astonishing rapidity through means less proportionate than its success; and what ought to shock and outrage spirits only served to give it new strength. A great people has suddenly changed its principles, customs, laws, and religion. Without reason and against all reason of political interest, glory or happiness, irrationality is flaunted. It seems to think only of being blinded, of humiliating itself, of grasping the means to make itself unhappy; it adopts the cruelest motions, welcomes the most senseless proposals, and applauds the most ridiculous braggarts.

Laws like HB 439 (and, for that matter, SB 155), should shock and outrage our spirits. Let us not be blinded, cruel, and unhappy. I ask you all to vote NO on HB 439 and any similar proposals that may come before you.

Forgive the length of this letter, but I felt personally compelled to make my thoughts on this issue known and to oppose HB 493 (and, for that matter, SB 155). My family and I did not leave all we held dear in Philadelphia to "live free or shrug."

**METHODOLOGY:**

This bill establishes a criminal penalty for an assault committed against a person who is conveying public health or safety guidance during a declared state of emergency. This bill contains a penalty that may have an impact on the New Hampshire judicial and correctional systems. There is no method to determine how many charges would be brought as a result of the changes contained in this bill to determine the fiscal impact on expenditures. However, the entities impacted have provided the potential costs associated with these penalties below.
