  important form, it is inconvenient for many and it is hard to ensure that everyone fills it out.
  He did note that legislators do have an obligation to update their form if their financial
  situation changes.
- Rep. Gordon said that, under HB 190, instead of the form being filed yearly, it would only be
  filed at the beginning of a legislative session in the first year of the biennium.
