**Summary of Testimony Presented:** 

### Representative Sherman Packard, Rockingham 5

- Rep. Packard said, this bill started out by asking for a permit for the Masons of NH. The COVID-19 pandemic tied up this bill last year. This time around, the House combined this bill with the Knights of Columbus and Gold Star families. It now has three parts.
- Sen. Watters said, are we getting any more bills like this? Maybe we can reconcile the bills together.
  - o Rep. Packard said he did not have an answer.

### Kevin Grady, State Veterans Advisory Committee

- Mr. Grady testified in support of this bill.
- Mr. Grady said he is from Hooksett, NH and an Airforce veteran.
- Mr. Grady said, we voted on the free decals for gold star families portion of the bill.
- Mr. Grady said, as someone who was involved when we started with stickers, and while MA has license plates for everything, we came up with the idea of stickers to save money and simplify our computer systems. We basically told anybody who wants a plate that they would get a decal plate. I am led to believe the initial lot of these stickers is about 200 or so stickers ordered. We do not need a \$10.00 cost. That is a nuisance charge.
- Mr. Grady said, the more visibly we can have for when veterans and our family members serve the better. We support the bill.

### Representative Tom Walsh, Merrimack 24

- Rep. Walsh said, the House committee joined together all three of these bills with decals. There are no more bills coming over with decal plates.
- Sen. Birdsell asked, are all bills with decals in this bill?
- Sen. Watters said, I wanted to be sure we had the roman numerals right.
- Sen. Birdsell said, maybe we can have the House add the Senate bill we had.

### Warren Perry, Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services.

Mr. Perry said, please waive the fee for gold star families. It is absolutely the right thing
to do. We can purchase 50 stickers for less than \$200.00 and we currently have 50 sets of
stickers on hand.
