Summary of testimony presented in support:

Senator Tom Sherman

Senate District 24

- Senator Sherman introduced SB 21.
- Senator Sherman said that the issue in SB 21 has been part of an ongoing saga that began with a desire to give the town of Greenland representation on the Pease Development Authority (PDA) Board of Directors. The initial bill to do so (HB 243, 2019) added a new member to the Board. It was then negotiated and amended so that Portsmouth would give up a half-member on the Board so that Newington and Greenland could share a member, which

- would be more proportional to the amount of land in the PDA owned by the towns.
- HB 243 (2019) included a provision to change the quorum, as it was adding a new member to the Board. When the bill was amended and changed to a reallocation of a half-member, the quorum change wasn't corrected. This made the quorum requirement impossible to meet.
- The original bill did not take effect until April of 2021. The quorum issue was noted at the signing of the bill but the Governor signed the bill with the understanding that the quorum issue would be addressed in 2020.
- SB 592 (2020) would have corrected the quorum issue and passed the Senate on the consent calendar but, with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, was rolled into the omnibus amendment to HB 1234 (2020), which was vetoed.
- Senator Sherman said that Senate President Morse and Senators Soucy and Carson all
 understand the time pressure involved with the quorum issue, as the incorrect quorum
 requirement will take effect in April.
