Summary of testimony presented:

Sen. Sherman

- He said this was filed last session but tabled due to COVID-19.
- Current law mandates that when you sign up for charitable gaming, someone from the organization must show up every day to show they are active with the gaming parlor and sign an affidavit that you're there.
- The Lottery Commission said this dated back to days when charitable organizations did their own gaming, and the requirement is outdated.
- The Lottery Commission asked if he wanted to get rid of it altogether.
- Sen. Sherman decided to draft the bill such that if a charity signs up for five days in a row of gaming, someone from the charity should only have to show up one of those days.
- Many of these are small organization where the principles have full time jobs.
- The lottery commission does support this.

Sen. Daniels asked if there is a necessity for somebody to be there. He questioned what the purpose is in having someone there. He added that he can see value in identifying the charity being sponsored for those days but suggested that could be done with a banner or handouts.

Sen. Sherman said the only purpose is to verify the connection between the facility and the charity. The charities market the fact that their charity is being featured at a facility, and this has nothing to do with that. Its an old requirement. This is burdensome. The only benefit of having the requirement that they show up once during the contract period is that it assures a documented connection between the facility and the charitable organization.

Sen. Daniels asked Sen. Sherman if he would object to an amendment that would not require a person to sign in but would require identification of the charity being sponsored.

Sen. Sherman said he would not object.

Rick Newman

- He supports the bill.
- He would support the amendment suggested by Sen. Daniels.
- The requirement may sound like it is not much of anything, but it does make it difficult for charities who are far away from the game room to get dates.
- They have difficulty getting someone to drive to the game room.
- It can be cumbersome to do at Hampton Beach in the summer.
- The person who does go to show up is not allowed to play. He does not understand that rule.

Sen. Giuda said it seems this is an unnecessary regulation. He asked if it would be appropriate to strike the entire statute.

Mr. Newman said he does not think that would be a problem.

Sen. Giuda asked Sen. Daniels what he thought, and he was fine with the idea.

Janice Severance

- She is a member of two local nonprofit charities who have been recipient of games of chance proceeds, which are beneficial to sustain their organizations.
- They are associated with the game room on Hampton Beach Blvd. and there are traffic issues, plus it is two hours round trip from Concord.
- She noted it is only open in the summer and it is challenging to find volunteers to drive over during 10 game days for a 5-minute sign in process.

Sen. Giuda asked her if repealing the entire provision would be acceptable and she said yes. Ms. Severance also noted that the license is always displayed at the game room, so people know what the charity is that day.

Michael Lupoli

- He echoed Ms. Severance's last statement.
- He is the owner and operator of the casino in Hampton Beach.
- He wants to support Ms. Severance and her statement regarding having the charities come in and sign.

CURRENTLY, WE ARE ASSOCIATED WITH A GAME ROOM ON HAMPTON BEACH BOULEVARD WHICH IS A TWO-HOUR ROUND TRIP FROM CONCORD TO SIGN IN AT THE GAME ROOM, IF THE TRAFFIC IS FLOWING. IF THE TRAFFIC IS BACKED UP GOING INTO THE BEACH, DRIVE TIME IS SO MUCH LONGER AS YOU CAN IMAGINE. THE GAME ROOM IS CURRENTLY ONLY OPEN IN THE SUMMER AND IT IS CHALLENGING TO FIND VOLUNTEERS TO DRIVE OVER FOR THE 10 GAME DAYS EACH CHARITY IS AWARDED DURING THEIR SUMMER VACATIONS FOR A 5-MINUTE SIGN IN PROCESS.
