AN ACT relative to charity gaming licenses.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1 Charitable Gaming Licenses. Amend RSA 287-D:6, IV and V to read as follows:
- 2 IV. Only one license shall be issued to each applicant [~~in any 12 month period~~] *per year* to
- 3 operate games of chance for 10 days, which 10 days need not be consecutive.
- 4 V. Licenses shall expire [~~12 months from the date of issue or after the completion of the~~
- 5 ~~tenth game date, whichever comes first~~] *on December 31.*
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.

**Bill Analysis:** This bill changes the term of a charity gaming license from 12 months from issue to annually expiring on December 31.

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**Who supports the bill:** Sen. Morse, Rick Newman, Fran Wendelboe

**Who opposes the bill:** No one

**Who is neutral on the bill:** Valerie King (NH Lottery Commission)

**Summary of testimony presented:**

Sen. Morse said this is a straightforward bill to streamline the administration of charity gaming. Currently, they can operate 10 times per year and this bill doesn't change that. Charitable gaming licenses currently reset on the anniversary of issuance of the license. Groups running charitable games have to track the anniversary of each charity. This bill resets the expiration clock to Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> for all licenses. It is a simple change that will make it easier to administer charity gaming in NH.

Rick Newman represented the NH Charitable Gaming Operators Association. They support the bill. Up until 2018, the method outlined in this bill was how licenses were handled. He wasn't sure why it was changed but it has caused confusion for charities and game operators. It is difficult to keep track of 500 anniversary dates. This will make it easier for all.
