I. Summary of testimony presented in support:

#### Senator Bob Giuda

- This bill needs to be moved on expeditiously in order for the towns to bring warrant articles forward to complete the requested legislation this Spring at their Town Meetings.
- It allows a change of boundaries between Tilton and Northfield by enabling Tilton to incorporate Atkinson Island, also known as Tilton Island, into its boundaries.
- This has been agreed upon between the two Communities Leadership and their Representatives.
- This will also change the County of Island from Merrimack to Belknap.
- Senator Gray asked if he could clarify what is needed for the Communities to agree to this, which is addressed in paragraph one of the bill.
  - o Senator Giuda replied that it will require a 2/3rds vote, of the voters present and voting, at the annual Town Meetings in Northfield and Tilton.

#### Representative Juliet Harvey-Bolia

• She is in support of the bill and thinks it will be great for the betterment of both Communities.

#### Jeanne Forester - Town Administrator, Tilton

- In 1987, the heirs of Charles Tilton deeded the area known as Atkinson Island, also known as Tilton Island, to the towns of Tilton and Northfield to be used exclusively for a public park.
- Currently, the Park is enjoyed by many at concerts in the park, picnicking on the Island, fishing off the edge and many other town sponsored events.
- It sits in the middle of the Winnipesaukee River and is in the town of Northfield and the County of Merrimack.
- It is only accessible through the town of Tilton via a historic, rod iron and cast bridge.
- For many years, the two towns have shared expenses to maintain the Island, but as the
  years have passed there has been a desire by both towns to change the ownership status
  of the Island.
- Tilton has had warrant articles in 2017 and again in 2019 to ask the voters to take full responsibility of the Island.
- Northfield has had sister warrant articles asking their residents to convey the property to Tilton.
- In both cases the residents have voted in the affirmative.
- Attempts to contact the heirs to allow this conveyance have been unsuccessful.
- The Towns have hired an attorney who consulted with Tom Donovan of the Attorney General's office, and the consensus was, that the best way to transfer the Island to Tilton is through this legislation.
