Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Fees of Sheriffs and Deputy Sheriffs. Amend RSA 104:31, I-IX-b to read as follows:
- I. For service of every writ, except as otherwise specifically provided, [\$25] \$30; for every service of a writ of possession, [\$25] \$30; for service of every demand for rent, eviction notice, small claims notice, process, and notice of execution, [\$25] \$30; and for service of every subpoena, [-\$25] \$30.
- II. For service of a bill, libel or petition, [\$25] \$30; provided that service of a petition with restraining order shall be [\$30] \$36.
- 8 III. For making an attachment of personal property or making a bulky attachment, [\$25] 9 \$30.
 - IV. In every county for actual travel to serve any writ, notice, subpoena, process, or execution, to be reckoned from the place of service to the sheriff's office or substation, and for travel to attend any court by the order thereof, to be reckoned from the sheriff's office or substation to the court, each mile, each way, at the current federal rate. Mileage shall be paid only once when service requested by the same party on multiple individuals related to the same case or matter living at the same address, building, or complex can be reasonably made on the same trip.
 - V. For levying executions, or sheriff sales or both, on the dollar, for the first \$100 levied, [\$.04] \$.05; for all above \$100, and not exceeding \$500, [\$.03] \$.04; for all above \$500, and not exceeding \$1,000, [\$.02] \$.03; for all above \$1,000, [\$.01] \$.02; minimum fee, [-\$10] \$12.
 - VI. For making copies of writs, each page, \$1; for postage and handling of writs, each, [\$1] a minimum charge of \$1 with a maximum not to exceed United States Postal Service rates.
 - VII. For leaving the copy and return required in the attachment of real estate at the office or the dwelling house of a register of deeds, [\$25] \$30.
- VIII. For every service of a writ of attachment with a petition or writ of summons with a petition, [\$30] \$36; for every service of a writ of replevin, [\$25] \$30; for every non est return, [\$10] \$12.
 - IX. For making a search, for taking an inventory, for conducting a sale or for waiting time, [\$25] \$30 per hour for the first hour, additional time charged for 30 minute increments at \$15 in addition to any other fees specified in this section.
- IX-a. For service of a civil order of arrest, [-\$25] \$30 to be charged to the defendant unless the defendant, upon motion, shows the court good cause for failure to appear.

Summary of testimony presented in support:

Senator D'Allesandro, Prime Sponsor:

- Senator D'Allesandro sponsored the very same bill last session, which passed the Senate on a voice vote.
- The NH Sheriffs Association requested sponsorship of the bill. Their fees for service have not been increased for more than 10 years. They are asking for a moderate increase to cover their own increases in the cost of fuel, wages, mailing, the cost of cruisers, and every other aspect of writ services.
- We all have to recognize the cost of doing business has increased over the last 10 years.

Sheriff Eli Rivera, Cheshire County:

• In response to a question posed by Senator Giuda concerning whether or not service of process on different parties can be made on the same trip, Sheriff Rivera explained there might be occasions where a sheriff might visit a home and serve multiple parties at that home with different papers. Instead of applying mileage to both parties, mileage would only be applied to one, due to traveling to the same location. If they were serving on a different date, they would again apply mileage. Senator Giuda rephrased his question using the example of Grafton County, which could have processes to serve on individuals in 3 separate towns. Is there a policy that might perhaps only charge for the farthest location, or is each location charged the full cost of the service? Senator Giuda is looking for ways to make it more efficient. Sheriff Rivera explained in such a case, the individuals would incur the cost from the office to the location, regardless of the Sheriff having to serve multiple papers throughout the county. Each paper has mileage attached to it from the Sheriff's Office to where it is

being served. The difficulty with Senator Giuda's suggestion is that they would be unable to determine how to apply the mileage and to whom to charge the mileage. Multiple attempts might be required, but in other instances papers might just be left at the home.

- The Association is requesting minor increases in service fees, which have not increased since 2010. The increase in costs since that time have all been absorbed by county taxpayers.
- It is time to increase these fees, and share some of the costs with the actual entities using the services.
- The average increase is approximately \$5 per service.
- There is a mechanism in place for an exemption by court motion to have the fees waived.
- Senator Daniels inquired if there was any expense to the state. Sheriff Rivera indicated in the case where the court waives the fee for service, the court assumes the liability of payment.
- Senator Rosenwald noted the fiscal note on the bill indicates an increase in revenue to the county of \$400,000. She wondered if that amount was offsetting county costs that we're not seeing, or is it merely additional revenue to the county. Sheriff Rivera stated it would offset the costs of the services they provide, to some degree. They have a statutory obligation to provide the services.
- Senator Hennessey sought confirmation that the changes in the proposal will not generate revenue, but merely offset the expense. Sheriff Rivera indicated Senator Hennessey was correct; not all of the expense would be offset, however.

Marissa Chase, NH Association for Justice:

- Their members are the attorneys who typically pay these service fees when papers must be served for clients.
- Ms. Chase cited a few instances where their members were charged for mileage
 twice to the same address, i.e., a husband and wife living at the same location
 being served at the same time, on the same trip, for the same case. Mileage
 should only be charged once, as the sheriff is driving to that location only once.
 If multiple attempts are required, mileage should be charged multiple times.
