AN ACT relative to the governor's duties during a state of emergency.

#### **ANALYSIS**

This bill clarifies the governor's duty to provide a list of expenditures in a state of emergency to the executive council.

#### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

#### In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two

AN ACT relative to the governor's duties during a state of emergency.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Homeland Security; Governor Duty. Amend RSA 21-P:43-a to read as follows:
  2 21-P:43-a Governor Duty. The governor shall provide a list of all expenditures pursuant to this
  3 subdivision under a state of emergency to the executive council [for informational purposes only]
  4 within 30 days of the expenditure[, in order to ensure transparency].
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
