Matt Southerton, CSF, Not sure that other schools are required to share all of this info, so why this bill? Not sure how they would address the accreditation status. Regarding enrollment, if a private school refuses to share, what legal authority do they have to force this?

#### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

## In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two

AN ACT relative to education service providers under the education freedom account program.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 Education Freedom Accounts Program; Authority and Responsibilities of the Scholarship
2	Organization; Directory. Amend RSA 194-F:4, I to read as follows:
3	I. The scholarship organization shall maintain an updated list of education service providers
4	and shall ensure that the list is publicly available through various sources, including the Internet.
5	The scholarship organization shall compile a directory of public profiles for each
6	education service provider listed that includes, but is not limited to:
7	(a) Name of school and administrator, as well as contact information.
8	(b) School performance data, including test scores, retention rates, and
9	graduation rates, if applicable.
10	(c) Written school discipline policy.
11	(d) Curriculum and teaching philosophy.
12	(e) Years in operation.
13	(f) Accreditation status.
14	(g) Transportation options.
15	(h) Information for students with disabilities, including services provided,
16	percent of students receiving services, and whether teachers are trained and certified to
17	serve students with disabilities.
18	(i) Total enrollment.
19	(j) Tuition rates, fees, and financial aid options.
20	2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
