### HOUSE ELECTION LAW COMMITTEE

I write in support of HB 1157. Modern digital communication interfaces like ethernet and wireless are two-way. While there is convenience of reading out information from a device, the device is subject to receiving data and programming via communication. It's locking out input is not absolute. The only sure confirmation of device security is AIR-GAP... not being physically connected. Citizen's confidence in election integrity is too precious to assume anything. This bill desires that no electronic ballot counting device to have access to or be connected to the INTERNET.

Note that the "internet" is a specific term meaning external to one's own internal network. This bill does not deny the state or political subdivision from connecting ballot counting devices within an <a href="INTRANET">INTRANET</a> for the convenience of monitoring election process, accumulating counts, controlling security, identifying malfunctioning machines, etc.

### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

### In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two

AN ACT relative to electronic ballot counting devices.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Paragraph; Electronic Ballot Counting Devices; Rules; Internet Access. Amend RSA 656:42 by inserting after paragraph IX the following new paragraph:
- 3 X. No electronic ballot counting device shall have access to or be connected to the Internet.
- 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
