AN ACT authorizing the use of side exhausts for antique vehicles.

SPONSORS: Rep. Walsh, Merr. 24

COMMITTEE: Transportation

ANALYSIS

This bill allows antique motor vehicles to use a side exhaust system.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two

AN ACT authorizing the use of side exhausts for antique vehicles.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Section; Equipment Authorized for Antique Motor Vehicles. Amend RSA 266 by
2 inserting after section 116 the following new section:

3 266:117 Equipment Authorized for Antique Motor Vehicles. Exhaust systems discharging along
4 the side of the vehicle shall be allowed on antique motor vehicles, provided the exhaust discharge
5 point is to the rear of the rear edge of the front door and such system shall direct exhaust gas away
6 from the vehicle.

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
