Rep Yokela sponsor Support The purpose is to clarify that schools are public bodies and subject to RSA 91-A. Right-to-Know NH told me they were not happy with the adding any list to 91-A, so I have an amendment 2022-0191h that moves the language into a different statute.

Q Gordon: So, these are already covered by 91-A?

Ans: Yes. This is just to clarify these particular documents.

Q Would this to some extent limit what people think is subject to 91-A?

Ans: I did the best I could.

Margaret Burns NHMA Opposed 91-A already defines what is a government record and almost everything falls under that definition. Adding a list like this is unnecessary. If the bill is amended to only deal with retention of records under a school statute, we would have e no position as long as it does only that.

Barrett Christina: NHSBA Opposed I agree with Ms., Burns. He retention of records is spelled out in RSA 33. Some things on the list are problematic: 'Out of district Placement' information for example can't be redacted enough to prevent identification in a small district. Other types of information have similar problems. There is no corresponding statute for school districts similar to RSA 33:3. About 15 years ago there was a retention period listing on the Department of Education website. It has been removed they too k it down but its information is still accurate. The listing is comprehensive. In the amendment the retention period is not explicit.

Dear Honorable Members of the Judiciary Committee;

My name is Laura Colquhoun and I live in Nashua NH. I am opposed to HB 1603-FN, amending the RSA to list specific school records as governmental records under the right to know law.

RSA 91-A definition of a governmental record encompasses, in broad terms, the specific language that has been added with this bill. The broad language defining records should not be juxtaposed with a list of specific school records as called out in this amendment for curriculum, by-laws and policies, receipts, expenditures, RFP and RFP, etc. If the legislature starts adding specific records, RSA 91-A could become pages of listed public documents.

While school records are listed in this amendment, every other municipal office could request amendments to list their records to be included. RSA 33-a is the municipal disposition and retention schedule. This document provides a list of specific documents and document types to be maintained.

Relative to school documents, RSA 189:29-a delineates records retention and disposition as it applies to School Boards, superintendents, teachers and truant officers. Boards are responsible for setting policy directing Superintendents to establish retention schedules for all official school records. It is unclear why a state level record retention document does not exist for school records.

A governmental record as defined by RSA 91-A means: any information created, accepted, or obtained by, or on behalf of, any public body, or a quorum or majority thereof, or any public agency in furtherance of its official function. Without limiting the foregoing, the term "governmental records" includes any written communication or other information, whether in paper, electronic, or other physical form, received by a quorum or majority of a public body in furtherance of its official function, whether at a meeting or outside a meeting of the body. The term "governmental records" shall also include the term "public records." and public bodies include, by definition, any school district or SAU.

Specific exemptions defined in RSA 91-A:5 provide the restrictions that apply to records for non-disclosure.

Please keep the language for governmental records in the broadest possible terms and oppose HB1603-FN.

19	(6) Out-of-district placement information with redaction of student

21	(7) Complaints and responses to complaints with redaction of student
22	identifying information.
23	(8) Communications with transportation providers related to route
24	planning, staffing shortages, or any other matter that affects the ability of all students to
25	be transported to and from school in a timely manner.
26	(9) Communication or other information about subparagraphs (1)-(8).
